Arthur Scott Pritts, 50, of Donegal, passed away Thursday October 26, 2023 due to injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident. He was born August 20, 1973 in Connellsville a son of Arthur G. Pritts of Indian Head and the late Bonny L. Hull Pritts. Art was a graduate of Connellsville High Area High School with the class of 1991. He was a Veteran of the U.S. Navy having served during the Gulf War on the Aircraft Carrier George Washington CVN 73. He was a member of the Donegal VFW, the Donegal American Legion and the Mt. Pleasant VFW. Art had worked for years as Manager for Busy Beaver in Mt. Pleasant and was most recently working as a Salesman for Allegheny Lumber. My mom and his mom ended up getting him reinstated back on the bus after informing the school of everything that happened. For the rest of the school year I sat in the back of the bus with Tami and Scotty protecting me. I never felt scared because I had him to make me feel safe. We were never really close after that year due to the age difference but every time we'd see each other he'd remind me that if I ever needed him he'd be there. This one hurts....hurts A LOT.
