Any of his cars, tractors, and machinery, no matter the year or mileage, were always kept in pristine condition and he knew them inside and out. Everyone always knew "Pap"

could fix anything or at least "boss the job" and tell you how to fix it. He always strived to work hard and to be the best he could be at everything he did. After starting out living in a chicken coop, he worked hard for a warm home and a roof over his head that was made possible by his own blood, sweat, tears, and love. Under that roof he would go onto raise a family of 4 children alongside his wife Anna Mae Hall (Cole), and then continued to watch his children's children make memories in those same walls as well. He made sure his children had the best life he could offer them, and that they and their children would go on to hold their heads high in their name, just as he did. In addition to his parents, Edwin was predeceased by his siblings James Milton Hall, John Edgar Hall, Mary Lou Cooke, and Eugene Hall.
