Evangeline Joy (Imel) Sleasman, age 80, of Indian Head, PA, died peacefully at home on Friday, July 3, 2020 after battling Alzheimers. Evangeline was born in Indian Head on September 29, 1939 to the late Ernest and Helen (Stairs) Imel.
