Senneth enjoyed NASCAR racing and was a partner in the Motordrome Speedway in Smithton. He was an avid fan for his son Chuck and several friends who raced. He loved going to the auction in Rogers, Ohio with his buddies, Ed, Dave, and Bob. He loved a good buy and would often come home with a truck load of treasures, including shrubs and flowers. He enjoyed flowers and had a passion for daffodils. His beautiful daffodils surround his house each spring in a showy display. After retirement,

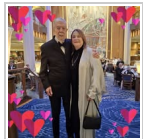
