



Sheldon Earl Hinebaugh

Sheldon Earl Hinebaugh, of Jones Mills, "Earl" to all who knew him, was born at home in Bruceton Mills, W. Va., to Ray and Myrtle (Smithberger) Hinebaugh, Sept. 8, 1928. In the fullness of time, Wednesday, April 21, 2021, Earl passed at home, having lived generously and gratefully for more than 92 years. His parents and two dear sisters, Donna Kay Hinebaugh and Elaine Field, preceded him. He is survived by his beloved wife of 67 years, Martha Nell (Hill) Hinebaugh. They raised two sons, Tim (with wife Gayle, in Somerset) and Mark (with wife Margie, in Monroeville). Earl leaves behind younger brother William Ray Hinebaugh, of Florida, grandchildren, Nicole, James and Weston, and four great-grandchildren. Earl graduated from Bruceton High School and attended WVU. He served with the Army in Korea from 1951 to 1953. He and Martha Nell raised their family in Monroeville, while Earl rose from laborer to Sr. Melter at LTV Steel (formally J&L). In 1975, Earl and Martha Nell purchased property in Jones Mills. They created a home "Hinebaugh Hill", and there they have enjoyed the natural beauty and the love of family and friends for more than 40 years. Earl will be buried with military honors at the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies.
